FROM THE DIRECTOR'S DESK

Giving back.....

"You make a living by what you get. You make a life by what you give."

I found this quote to be accurate and relevant as we approach the holiday season. Clarion Forest VNA, Inc. recently had the opportunity to give back by participating in the Walk to End Alzheimer's on September 28. I was so proud of the team members who were able to participate. As a home health and hospice provider we see the detrimental effects of this disease. We also try to provide support to family members by providing their loved ones care in our Adult Daily Living Center and in their own homes with Private Duty.

Our agency has seen how this disease strips away at the pride and dignity of those it chooses to afflict. It is also so hard on family and friends to watch this horrific disease process plant its seed and grow.

Our agency was most impressed with the guest speaker at the Walk to End Alzheimer's event. The speaker was the spouse of a hospice patient with our agency who courageously shared her journey of caring for her spouse who was diagnosed with Lewy Body Dementia. I would like to take this opportunity to share some excerpts from her letter:

I was asked to speak to you about my late husband and our journey through Lewy Body Dementia. After a three month wait, we finally met with the neurologist in June of 2015, it was the culmination of our desire to get answers to my husband's many symptoms that had plagued him for years. After a thorough exam and MRI of his crania, the doctor told me my husband was suffering from Lewy Body Dementia. I had so many questions. This was a disease I had never heard of and knew nothing about. I had thought he had the beginnings of Alzheimer's disease, due to the fact his mother died of Alzheimer's. My husband was just 72.

I began to notice on my facebook support site that more and more caretakers recommended hospice for LBD. Often the end comes so quickly. I began thinking about this but I really didn't want any strangers in my home. But in the fall of 2022, I was dressing him, sometimes feeding him and bathing him. In October, he no longer wanted to leave the house. In November I decided to reach out to hospice.

I would like to take a moment to thank Hospice and the VNA for their comfort and support during this difficult time. From the receptionists to the secretaries to caretakers and nurses I extend my gratitude.

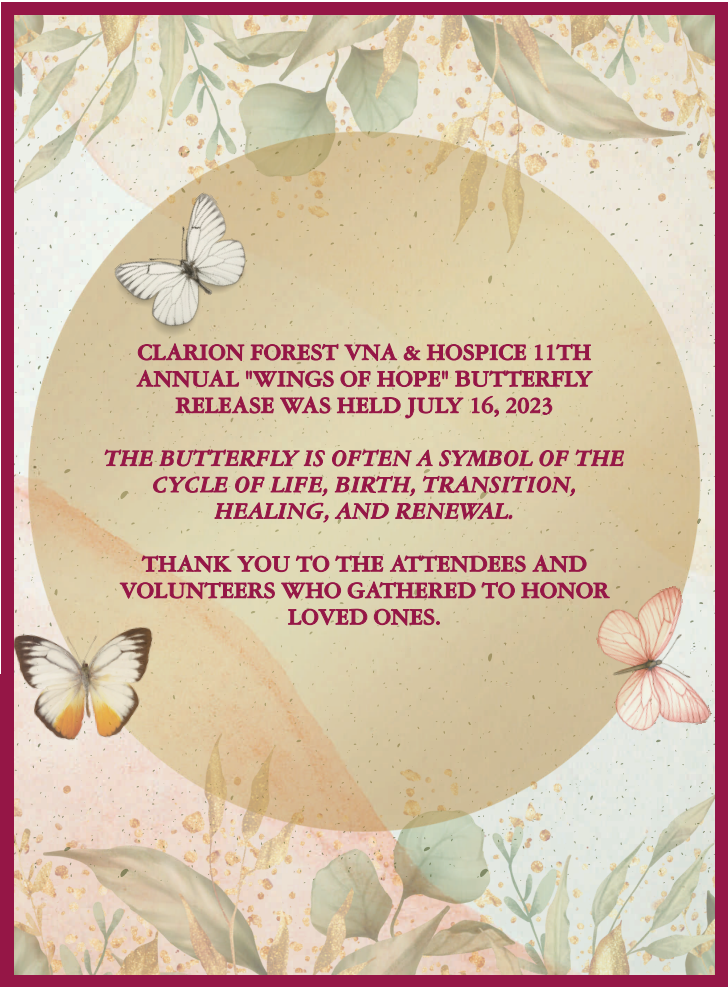
