This is a four-person "scramble" tournament. Each person will hit a tee shot, select the best shot, and from that spot, everyone hits a second ball.

Continue this procedure until the ball has been holed out.

Please refer to Rule #11: Bogey Is Your Friend

Rules of Play:

1. USGA rule of golf shall govern play except where modified on the scorecard and below.
2. Events on every hole for a chance to win a cash prize. Donate to play our chipping and putting contests.
3. Ball may be placed in the rough or fairway by hand within club length, no nearer to the hole.
4. Tie Rule: All ties will be broken by scorecard playoff starting with the hardest handicap hole.
5. Rain Rule: If play is stopped due to heavy rain or lightning, the committee will determine if a random drawing will be held to determine the winners. If play is stopped and then resumed, you will start play at the spot where you stopped. Therefore, please remember to mark your ball if play is halted.
6. Out of bounds: Road on #17. Unclear woods on #2 & #4. High grass left on #3. Deep grass to the right on #11, #12, #14 & #16. Also tree line to the left on #8 & #9.
7. A team cannot win both Scorecard Draw and Callaway.
8. Mulligans must be purchased at the registration table in a set of four for \$20.00. Each mulligan is worth one extra shot anywhere on the hole of the player's choice. Once the shot is taken, the mulligan cannot be used again. Maximum of one set of mulligans per team (one per person). Mulligans cannot be used for hole-in-one contests.
9. Skins are \$20.00 per team.
10. Hole #8 – Hole in one in any of the holes wins a Clarion Oaks Lady's Membership. After everyone hits their drives, finish out by using the closest hole to your best ball. (*If more than one person gets a hole in one, the winner's name will be drawn from a hat.)
11. "BOGEY IS YOUR FRIEND": At each hole, your play will end when you bogey each hole -1 over par.
